

Heathcote himself came late to racing, at age 34, after being a tour operator for many years and living a nomadic existence travelling around Europe. When he came home his brother was involved in racing and

gave him his start. "The second horse I put a saddle on won a \$75,000 race so it was a dream start for me, but I really applied myself, learnt my trade."

Heathcote has won the last three Brisbane Premierships and is hopeful he can win a fourth. He recently won his first Group 1 open handicap at Caulfield, the Oakleigh Plate.

"Oh yeah it's pretty good," he beams, "but getting dressed up in the sharp suit and tie, drinking in the bar after a win, that's about two per cent of it. It's a great two per cent, but the rest is the very early starts, the hard

slog to get the horses up to scratch so they can do their best and, as a trainer, you're only as good as the horses you train," says Heathcote.

You can keep your eye on Heathcote's form in the upcoming Brisbane Carnival when
